- More and more I feared God and could not live up to his expectation; unworthy

<u>Psalm 51:</u> Background to after all of David's sin (Bathsheba) God says you're a man after my own heart.

God has always been a God of grace

- Adam and Eve in Genesis, when they had sinned they heard God, they felt fear, they had welcomed in sin and shame...and God came and pursued them
- Our sin tries to cause us to flee from God, causes God to pursue us

God shows and proves he is a God of grace by all his interactions and meetings with sinners, throughout the bible! "A mother can forget her newborn but I will never forget you"

Some very cool insight:

Jesus was the peace offering, the free will offering In Leviticus Chapter 1 is a free will offering, giving unto God out of my joy to him; if a lamb, make perfect and without blemish

- killed on the north side of the altar
- When Jesus was crucified he was killed in the north side
- all other sacrifices elsewhere

We have to receive his FREEWILL offering!

- He wasn't forced to die for us, HE freely chose to lay down his life (John 10:18)

Genesis 22:1-19 a prophetic image of Jesus and the Father:

When Abraham brought his 30 year old son, Isaac to sacrifice, Isaac carried the wood, he was strong enough to resist his Father, he asked Abraham what they were doing and Abraham said:

- God himself will provide the sacrifice
- God himself will be the sacrifice

Isaac was willing...Jesus willingly laid his down his life *Some more very cool insight:*

Luke 22, Why did Jesus ask not my will but yours be done? At that time there was a custom, the bridal price that a groom pays to marry his bride. The bride has no say, the groom has no say, the 2 fathers negotiate the bridal price.

- the bride learns her worth
- The groom discovers how much she is worth
- Jesus was asking; is this the correct bridal price?
- The father said yes, Jesus gave the freewill offering My sin didn't kill Jesus, my sin was what Jesus paid for.
- Jesus didn't pay for what you might become but for who you are
- You don't set your own value or worth
- Never doubt your worth

Look each other in the eye; you are worthy.
