Small group optional guide: Psalm 51; God's playlist

UP; we grow in our love for Jesus through His word and worship

<u>WORD: Psalm 37:</u> an acrostic wisdom psalm: A psalm that teaches you to let go of anger by standing in the delight of God (psalm means praise, praise is worship, worship reveals Jesus)

Wisdom psalms are written for us to say back, their focus isn't the experience, but God's sovereignty and the character of a righteous person.

<u>Part 1 the structure</u>: it is an Acrostic poem; lines begin with succeeding letters of the Hebrew alphabet (Alef, Bet, Gimel...Tav)

With 4 general sections; how do we deal with anger when we face the injustice of seeing people get away with doing wrong?

- > not many experiences stir up anger, like unpunished injustice
- Each line is crafted, Each verse part of a bigger picture, It is a journey that has a completeness to it

<u>Part 2 the lessons</u>; the don't(s), the do's and heavenly perspective.

- Do not FRET (burn or be kindled with anger) do not envy they lead to sin
- DO v3 Trust, v4 Delight, v5 Commit, v7 Be still, v40 take refuge in Him
- Heavenly perspective; justice is coming, we have eternity where there will be no injustice

Is that enough? I need more. (Romans 7:24,25)

<u>Part 3 the hope is Jesus!</u> the key is found in Jesus, then worked out with the do's from a heavenly perspective.

Word continued...

How did Jesus react in the face of injustice?

Matthew 27, Jesus was silent in the face of the greatest injustice whilst carrying all injustice; He gave no room for anger, His focus was you, His delight (Isaiah 62:4, Hebrews 12:2)

What saves us from reacting in anger? In the face of injustice, stand in His delight of you! Psalm 37:4 delight in Him, you'll find you delight in Him.

From that place, do the do's with a heavenly perspective.

Questions to discuss:

- 1) How do you stand in the delight of God?
- 2) Split into pairs and pick of the list of do's << v3 Trust in the LORD, and do good / v4 Delight yourself in the LORD / v5 Commit your way to the LORD / v7 Be still before the LORD and wait patiently for him / v40 take refuge in Him >> what does this look like for you, how do you know you are doing it?
- 3) Do you read psalm 37:4 differently now?

WORSHIP: I love you Lord / 10,000 Reasons / Living Hope
