Mike: the veil torn in 2; that veil was 30ft high and 9cm thick! God tore that veil to give us access to come, He is offering each of us to come

Main Text Romans 8:1-14

As we Live, We need to make this choices everyday.

- 1) Daily Choose to uphold the Bible as the standard for our lives.
- 2 Timothy 3:16-17
- 2) Daily Choose to believe and Live by The Truth. John 8:32
- 3) Daily Choose to accept our salvation in Christ. Gal 2:20.

Choosing to Daily crucify the flesh, (die to self) and live by faith in Christ.

- 4) Daily Choose to Focus on Jesus. Hebrews 12:1-4
- 5) Daily Choose to walk by the Spirit.(and not the flesh Romans 8:8-9 // Gal 5:16-24.
