Freedom encounter: the Battle for our minds

IN: FELLOWSHIP

(the freedom in Christ truths are only true if someone is a Christian, if someone in your group hasn't given their life to Jesus yet, they can still speak them over someone else

- 1) Break into pairs, choose 1 of the freedom in Christ lists of truths (accepted, secure or significant)
- 2) Take it in turns to read them out loud, once you have read the list out loud, ask your partner if there was one truth you read that they think you struggled with
- If you feel comfortable, spend a couple of minutes looking at why you may struggle to believe that truth
- 4) Your partner now prays that truth into you, you can say it again and then use that key truth over the next 7 days (40 days will medically renew your mind)

Some key words from Sunday:

Dan Baptist - word of knowledge abdomen area, haven't told anyone, catches you by surprise

Rob Baker - sheep without a shepherd, Jesus had great compassion on them Mark 6:34

Zoe Baker - you are not forgotten, he sees you, he is for you, if you're confused know that there is a place for you

Safety and security in Christ:

1 John 5:18 The one who was born of God keeps them safe, and the evil one cannot harm them

James 4:7 Submit yourselves then to God. Resist the Devil and he will flee from you

Blocks to Freedom: Strongholds and demons
