Each one has... How has God called you to contribute and build up the church to glorify Jesus; with each other and with Jubilee

<u>Practically so that Jubilee glorifies Jesus:</u> 1 Corinthians 12:28 helping (refers to God's work bringing His helps of grace and power to meet someone's need, through a person He directs) administrating (a director who guides, administrates)

- Q) How do you help glorify Jesus as part of Jubilee? (serving teams? Roles?)
- Q) What are you passionate about / have skills or experience in, that Jubilee is doing or involved in?

It is God who builds Jubilee, we serve, he builds; the weight is His.

Q) What capacity do you have? (if you don't have it, you can't give it)

OUT: PRAYER

1) This Sunday Terry Virgo is preaching; we want to see the glory of God! (salvation, recommitment, freedom, healing)

UP: WORD

We want to see your Glory LORD.

Psalm 96:1-13; Exodus 33:18-20; Acts 10:38; 2Cor 3:18

The Glory of God is the weightiness, majesty, honour, splendour awesomeness of His Presence.

- He manifests His Glory in His person, His creation, His goodness and power (healings, miracles, signs and wonders), His Spirit, His incarnate Son, In and through us.

His glory results in awe, unexplainable happenings, testimonies, salvations, Revival and refreshing, Worship, Great joy and rejoicing

The way of the Glory :

The grace of God // Sacrifice and complete surrender // Death to self Believe in His goodness // Unquenchable, insatiable thirst and hunger Honour // Worship
