The bible is not a book on morality, it is Story of God intervening into a situation of fear, dread, and desperation. God's deliverance, the Saving intervention of God; the bible is all about the triumph of Christ!

Read 2 kings 7:1-9

The lepers were free from concern or agenda, they didn't try and hold onto life and discovered an abundance of treasure.

When they had discovered the treasure/provision, they enjoyed it before rushing off to tell/help the city.

- There was cynicism in the city that God could rescue...it didn't go well for them!

When we let go of agenda, even care for our own lives, we can truly experience the abundance of the treasures of God; joy, peace, access to his presence. (Philippians 3:8)

Challenge:

Q) How and when do you enjoy the presence of God?

Q) When we gather (JCC, prayer, small group) what do you expect to experience of God?

- None of us follow Jesus perfectly.

Q) What am I more concerned about than seeing the kingdom come and following Jesus? What holds me back; Finance? Relationships? Status/reputation?
